



Lesson #17: Jesus

Somebody has said that there are _____ different names in the Bible given to our Savior and Lord. Isaiah 9:6, alone, gives him several. He is called Wonderful, Counselor, the Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, and the Prince of Peace. You could call him our shepherd, our Savior, our Messiah, our Christ, our Mediator, our Great High Priest, our Intercessor, Our Door, our Rock, etc. etc. How many and multitudinous are the names that describe and depict the glory and majesty of Christ?

But out of all the names by which He is named, the most beautiful and set apart is the name “_____.” Of all names given to this man, none is as precious, as sweet, as devoted, as majestic as this one. In Philippians ____: _____. The Bible gives us a clear depiction of the name which is truly unique. It is here that we read of the name which is “_____ every name.” This morning I would like for us to take an in depth look at this name “Jesus.” Because of the unique glory of the name Jesus, you must recognize it as _____ in all your life.

THE NAME JESUS IS A UNIQUELY _____ NAME

There is something very special about this name.

- A. The name was _____ by the _____**
The name “Jesus” was handpicked by God. God instructed Joseph in a dream that this would be His name (Matthew 1:21). On this occasion the name is not left to the discretion of the parent, for this child is special and has a _____ that is to be expressed in the very _____. He was given. God had a purpose in the name given to this baby. He wasn’t doing things by accident. Philippians 2:9 makes it clear that “_____ has given Him [this] name.”
- B. This name points to the _____ of the _____**
The name Jesus means, “_____ is _____.” This precious name reveals a side of Jesus that many fail to grasp. While God is a God of _____ and _____. He is also purely and wholly _____ (1 John 4:8, 16). When the Father sent Jesus into the world, He was sending a message to humanity. It was a message that said, “I have not forgotten or forsaken you.”

To the name Jesus can only be attached praise, honor, and worship.

- A. This name calls for our _____**
“At the name of Jesus every knee shall bow” (Phil. 2:10). The bowing of the knee is a clear sign of _____ and _____. Christ is, and will be, honored by our humility in His presence. When we believing sinners speak of Him we must do so only with the utmost reverence and godly fear. Every knee bow! It doesn’t matter what is the context, our whole posture at the thought of Him is bowing and kneeling!
- B. This name calls for our _____**
The name of Jesus will also be confessed by the lips of every creature (Phil. 2:11). God gave Jesus a name that has a reputation that will recognize and commemorate who and what He is. It was a name meant to show honor! I wonder, what is that you are _____ today? Would you be accused of honoring the name of Jesus above all else?

THE NAME JESUS IS A UNIQUELY _____ NAME

The Bible teaches that there is power in the name of Jesus, but what does that mean? Can I use the name of Jesus to get anything I want from God?

- A. The _____ of this name is dynamic**
By its very definition the name Jesus speaks about _____. May I remind you that there is no name under heaven given among men whereby we must be saved (Acts 4:12). According to Philippians 2:5-8, this man Jesus climbed Calvary’s hill and died for all. He humbled Himself and died in the _____ place. This man named Jesus accomplished for the world a pathway to Heaven!
- B. The _____ of this name is dynamic**
This name carries the idea that we are speaking of a man who is yet alive! We do not hang our futures, base our _____ or exalt a name of one who is dead. No, our Savior lives! (Revelation 1:18; Matthew 28:5-6). Jesus has conquered death! He is worthy of exaltation! He is worthy of majesty!
