Key Text: Hebrews 7:25  
 Jesus Christ ever lives to make intercession for you. Once you were saved you were unconditionally set free from the penalty of past, present, and future sins.
2. **God’s \_\_\_\_\_ = \_\_\_\_\_**  
Key Text: 1 John 1:7-9  
 In the context of saying, “if we walk in the light we have fellowship” John writes and says “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive.” This is God’s \_\_\_\_\_ forgiveness and it is \_\_\_\_\_. Therefore, if there is a problem with our fellowship with God, it is *our* fault.
